NEW! County Opioid Quarterly Reports

In accordance with recommendations and state law regarding the reporting of timely opioid-related data, we are providing the latest update in a series of opioid data reports that the New York State Department of Health releases on a quarterly basis to support response to the growing opioid public health crisis.

This report contains statewide data on deaths, emergency department visits, and hospitalizations involving opioid overdoses, as well as data on admissions to substance use disorder treatment programs for heroin and other opioids, and on naloxone administration reports. These data are preliminary, may be updated in subsequent reports, and should therefore be interpreted with caution.

Please note that, beginning with the October 2023 Edition, the County Opioid Quarterly Reports are now available in an enhanced interactive dashboard

(<https://health.ny.gov/opioidquarterlyreport>). We are pleased to provide a number of updates and enhancements to our reports via this dashboard including:

- Data tables that can be filtered easily by indicator and county, allowing for the viewing of multiple counties at once
- Bar charts and trend graphs for state, region, county by indicator
- Maps showing county rates and counts

NEW! For the first time, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) is releasing [jurisdiction-specific epidemic growth status assessments](#) based on estimates of the effective reproduction number, known as R_t for [COVID-19](#) and [seasonal influenza \(flu\)](#). R_t is a measure of how a disease is spreading and allows us to assess whether a disease outbreak is likely to grow or decline. CDC will update these estimates weekly, on Fridays.

ICYMI: New Wastewater Data Dashboard for COVID-19 — CDC has launched a new [data dashboard](#) that dramatically improves the usability of wastewater data from National Wastewater Surveillance System (NWSS). Users can now explore national, regional, and state trends of COVID-19 virus detected in wastewater in all 50 states, U.S. territories, and select tribal nations.

Why is this important? This is the first time CDC has shared wastewater COVID-19 virus data at the state, regional, and national levels. Site-level data for COVID-19 virus in wastewater continues to be available on [CDC's COVID Data Tracker](#).

What's next? Data for seasonal flu and RSV are coming soon! The National Wastewater Surveillance System (NWSS) will be continuing to update all publicly available wastewater data displays to make wastewater data easier to understand and use.

ICYMI: Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report (MMWR) — Notes from the Field: The National Wastewater Surveillance System's Centers of Excellence Contributions to Public Health Action During the Respiratory Virus Season — Four U.S. Jurisdictions, 2022–23 — A [new report](#) from *Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report (MMWR)* discusses how CDC's National Wastewater Surveillance System (NWSS) Centers for Excellence used wastewater data to guide public health action in response to the spread of multiple respiratory illnesses (COVID-19, flu, respiratory syncytial virus [RSV], and enterovirus) during the 2022-2023 respiratory virus season.

ICYMI: Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report (MMWR) — SARS-CoV-2 Epidemiology and COVID-19 mRNA Vaccine Effectiveness Among Infants and Children Aged 6 Months–4 Years — New Vaccine Surveillance Network, United States, July 2022–September 2023 — Data from the New Vaccine Surveillance Network, a prospective population-based surveillance system, were used to estimate vaccine effectiveness using a test-negative, case-control design and describe the epidemiology of SARS-CoV-2 in infants and children aged 6 months–4 years during July 1, 2022–September 30, 2023.

Among vaccine-eligible children aged <5 years hospitalized or seeking care in emergency departments for acute respiratory illness during July 2022–September 2023, 86% had not received any COVID-19 vaccine. Despite low vaccination coverage, only 5% of children received a positive SARS-CoV-2 test result. Receipt of ≥ 2 COVID-19 mRNA vaccine doses was 40% effective (95% CI = 8%–60%) in preventing emergency department visits and hospitalization. ICYMI: Update on SARS-CoV-2 Variant BA.2.86 Being Tracked by CDC — Since CDC's [first post](#) on BA.2.86 in August 2023, the proportion of infections caused by BA.2.86 has slowly increased. In the [CDC Nowcast](#) posted Nov. 27, 2023, BA.2.86 is projected to account for 5-15% of currently circulating variants. At this time, BA.2.86 does not appear to be driving increases in infections or hospitalizations in the United States.
