



- 1. Open the file using Microsoft Paint.
- 2. Right click on an image to add your practice name, phone number and/or website.
- 3. Within the drop down, click edit to open.
- 4. At the top of the bar, click the "A" for text. Move your cursor to where you would like to type.
- 5. Add your practice name, phone number, phone number and/or website. Use the font "Arial" and font size 48 centered.




