

## What is Substance Use Disorder (SUD)?


Substance use disorders occur when the recurrent use of alcohol and/or drugs causes clinically significant impairment, affects a person's brain, including health problems, disability, and failure to meet major responsibilities at work, school, or home. (SAMHSA)






## Opioid Use Disorder Death Rate, 1990 to 2019 Number Of Deaths/100,000




#### Overdose Map

- Triggers a report for collaborative follow-up county support services





#### Overdose Map





#### **Mobile Clinic:**


- Equipped with Technology (Tele-medicine)




#### Key Accomplishments of the Taskforce

- Providing safe spaces for youth
- ✓ Increasing partnerships with like-minded agencies
- Spreading information through a PSA
- Collecting more detailed data
- ✓ Integrating booths into already established events
- Connecting with local churches
- Providing an advanced health class in high school
- Partnering with Helpful Hearts and local food banks
- EMS/Law enforcement could provide referrals to treatment providers
- Have presenters at school's parent nights

## Key Harm Reduction Strategies Utilized

Harm Reduction Strategy	Taskforce Activities
Work to minimize impact rather than condemn or ignore	<ul><li>Community Narcan Boxes</li><li>Sessions in School</li><li>Work with law enforcement</li></ul>
Educational program to reduce stigma	<ul><li>Mental health and Suicide prevention training</li></ul>
Fine-tuning policies based on opioid evolution	<ul><li>Employees Assistant Program (EAP)</li><li>Evidence based practice</li></ul>
