



KEY HIGHLIGHTS

<u>Top Problems</u>: Addiction to alcohol / drugs (illegal drug use, drinking & driving), mental health issues (emotional / physical abuse), cancer, obesity in adults (lack of physical activity, unhealthy eating), infectious diseases

<u>Least Available Services</u>: Mental health services, treatment for drug and alcohol use, nutrition counseling, wellness/healthy lifestyle services

Access to childcare, feelings of isolation, and financial situations are significantly worse than pre-COVID

Health literacy was an issue stakeholders noticed

"See a lot of trauma, see people in broken homes or dealing with abuse and drug addiction. Issues are a result of not growing up and living in a stable environment. We need to address our health care concerns and to ensure children have a stable environment and have access to services to grow up healthy and mitigate health problems."

"Habit" implies that a person is choosing to use substances or can choose to stop, which is incorrect.

Avoid use of "abuse" which is associated with negative judgments and punishment.

Address the misconception that medications "substitute" one drug for another and should only have a supplemental role in treatment.







OUTCOME #1: OVERDOSE WITNESS SAVED 141 LIVES WITH NARCAN




Overdose witnesses now administer Narcan more times than first responders.

Overdose victims have a higher chance of survival when witnesses/bystanders administer Narcan first.

Survival rates

- Overdose witness: 96.9%
- First responder: 91.7%

OUTCOME #2: OVERDOSE FATALITY RATE CUT IN HALF



Locations

- 75% of reported overdoses happen within the City of Auburn
- 25% of reported overdoses happen in rural areas

Fatality Rate


- Fewer overdoses result in fatalities than in 2020
- Overdoses in rural areas are more likely to end fatal
- Fatality rates have been cut in half since 2020
 - Rural (from 15% to 7%)
 - City (from 8% to 3%)


