1. Intentional Cross-pollination – Governance

- > PH Director is on **Ontario Cares Board of Directors**.
- Executive Director (ED) of Ontario Cares attends Ontario County Board of Supervisors Health and Human Services Committee
 - Standing committee meets every 3-weeks.
 - ► Face-to-face time with 6 board members, the County Administrator, the County Attorney, Public Health, DSS, Mental Health, Veterans Services, Youth Bureau and OFA.

2. Intentional Cross-pollination – Shared Coalition Work

- **▶ Ontario County Campbell Commission** (County Senior Leaders)
 - > PH Director and Ontario Cares Executive Director are members.
 - Convened by Member of Board of Supervisors, and County Administrator, Includes County Commissioners, Department Heads and two local CBO ED's
 - ▶ Identifies and addresses social determinants of health and decreases silo-ing.
- **▶** Ontario Care's Communitywide Coalitions:
- **Substance Misuse, Suicide Prevention**, and **Veterans Coalitions**.
 - Ontario Cares Staff coordinates and PH Staff actively assist and co-leads.
- Ontario County Health Collaborative
 - Lead by PH. Ontario Cares staff participate.

3. Shared Community Outreach, Education, & Resources

- Food distribution events (Organized by Ontario Cares. Partnership with Foodlink, Town of Canandaigua, Public Health, and volunteer groups)
- Co-host / Cross promote Community Events and Speakers
 - Semi-Annual Annual Drug Takeback Day (Partnership with Sherriff, Ontario Cares, and Public Health)
 - Suicide prevention speakers
 - School administrator events

4. Leader to Leader Relationship

Guiding Question: "What's best for our community?"

- Engage in regular open conversation
- Foster a culture of honest discussion
- Develop and cultivate mutual respect of ourselves as leaders and amongst our team members
- Actively engage and support continuous learning so we can adapt as community needs evolve.
